1. Scales (must be memorized):

- Intonation and tempo are very important. Practice with a metronome. The suggested minimum metronome speed is quarter note = 120 beats per minute. All scales must be performed at least 2 octaves.
 - Viola Major Scales: C, G, D, A, F, Bb, Eb, Ab, E

2. <u>Music of your choice:</u>

• Solo piece, etude or exercise no longer than 2 minutes. It does not need to be memorized. Accompaniment not permitted.
